



MARKER TARDIS

Show your nerdery with this marker that is a miniature of the time machine Tardis.

MATERIALS

- scraps of blue and white yarn
- 2.5 mm needles
- tapestry needle
- a ring or a clasp

SIZE

This one is about 4,5 cm x 1,7 cm.

ABBREVIATIONS

- k : knit
- p : purl
- st, sts : stitch, stitches
- k2tog o 2ptog : knit or purl 2 st together to make a decrease
- ssk : slip one, knit next st pass slip stitch over this one to make a decrease
- ssk2 : slip one, knit 2 stitches together, pass the slip stitch over.

REALISATION

Cast on 5 stitches.

Row 1: knit

Row 2 (wrong side) : k1, p1, k1, p1, k1

Rows 3, 4 and 5: knit

Row 6: k1, p1, k1, p1, k1

Rows 7 and 8: knit

Row 9 : knit 1 blue, 1 white, 1 blue, 1 white, 1 blue

Row 10: k1 blue, p1 white, k1 blue, p1 white, k1 blue

Row 11: blue, knit

Row 12: k1 blue, p3 white, k1 blue (keep a pretty long tail of the white yarn)

Row 13: ssk, k3, k2tog (3 sts)

Row 14: knit

Row 15: ssk2 (1st)

Cut the yarn and cast off.

FINISHING

Make 2 or 3 knots with the blue and the white yarn together. Sew the marker to the clasp (or toe the ring) with these two yarns.

Weave the ends.

It's done !
